

“Reduced Tuition” program

At Kids In Motion we offer two types of tuition reduction. Those are a “Low Income” scholarship program and a “Tuition Trade” program. Below both programs will be described. If you feel that either one of these programs applies to you, please speak directly with Ms. Piper. She can assist you further.

First, we offer a **“Low Income” scholarship program**. The program is very simple. You will need to provide proof that your household is receiving either Food Stamps or the specific child in question is participating in the Medicaid program. If this can be done, then your child qualifies for a four month reduction in tuition as follows;

1. Medicaid; 25% off monthly tuition
2. Food Stamps; 50% off monthly tuition

This program has limited enrollment. Scholarships cannot be combined. The duration of the scholarship is four months and proof of need must be resubmitted at the end of each four month term. Resubmission is not a guarantee of acceptance. Kids In Motion is not a non-profit organization. Kids In Motion does not receive grants for scholarship purposes. These scholarships come from the daily operation income of this business. The scholarships are rotated around to give every child an opportunity to participate in our programming. This is based solely on the number of applicants each term and how recently they have received a scholarship. For example; if there are new applicants and our quota is maxed, then the student’s scholarship for the longest consecutive running time will not be renewed and placed on the waiting list for the next four month term. This allows every child an opportunity.

Second, we offer a **“Tuition Trade” program**. This program is for those households who do not qualify for the “Low Income” scholarship program, but who find it a financial hardship to pay for Kids In Motion programming. This program has limited spots. Parents are given set tasks that must be completed each week, at Kids In Motion. These range from coaching, marketing, accounting, maintenance, janitorial, and secretarial. On occasion we do have one time jobs, usually construction, which can be applied to your tuition. These jobs are based on the needs of Kids In Motion and the skills of those needing to participate in the program. The program duration varies based on each case. Each applicant is handled one on one and are given a contract just as though it were a real job. Each contract will specify your duties, requirements, and compensation. Initially all those accepted will be placed on a 30 day trial period. If at the end of the trial period your performance does not meet the standards of Kids In Motion or you find it is not the right thing for you, then you will not be contracted.
